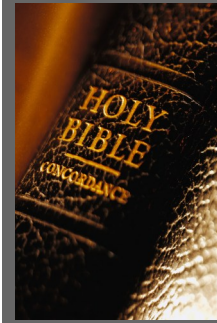
Parents, please do not use pre-paid envelopes for your tuition! These envelopes are for donations only. Thanks!

**JUNIOR HIGH GOLF!!**

There is currently one sanctioned event scheduled—the State Championship at St. Andrews Golf Club in East Chicago. This will take place mid-September. Joe Palumbo will be our head coach.
