AFTER SCHOOL CARE REMINDER

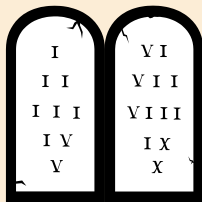
Parents, you must sign your student out of After School Care indicating the time you arrived, otherwise you will be charged for the full two-hour amount. Thanks for your help with this!

GRANDPARENTS' DAY AT CCA!

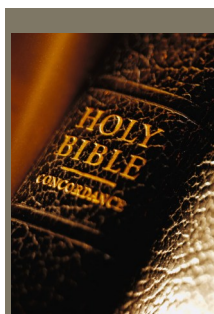

HANDBOOK CORNER

Athletic Code—Attendance

If a student-athlete misses school due to illness, he/she will not be eligible to participate in the day's sports activities. If a student-athlete becomes well enough to arrive at school by 12:00 noon and attends the remainder of the day, he/she will be able to participate in the evening's extra-curricular activities. Exceptions to this policy include funerals, doctor appointments, early dismissal, and prearranged absences.
