## GOLF TEAM ADVANCES TO STATE!!

After a nail-biting wait for final scores to be posted in the Sectional Golf tournament at Tuscola last Monday, Cornerstone's golf team will advance to the State Tournament beginning today!

It's been an amazing journey for our golfers who were not predicted to go this far. The team placed 3rd in regional play at El Paso on Oct. 4th behind El Paso and Eureka, but neither of those teams placed at Sectionals to advance to State.

At Monday's Sectionals Cornerstone tied for second place with an aggregate score of 335. In the case of a tie, rank is then determined by taking the scores of both teams' fifth place players. This meant that Drew Schwartz's score of 94 was put against the other team's fifth player who scored a 97. As a result, Cornerstone was placed 2nd.

Here are the results: Nathan Pavey (Senior) - 79; Austin Drake (Sophomore)- 81; Jordan Hall (Junior) - 82; Garrett Pavey (Freshman) - 93; Drew Schwartz (Junior) - 97; Jared Wilcox (Sophomore)—108.

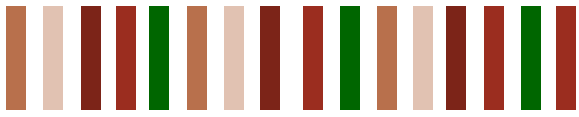
The team will play 18 holes today and another 18 tomorrow at Prairie Vista Golf Course in Bloomington. You can check the I.H.S.A. website for tee times.

Next Friday is an early dismissal day for all students as teachers will have an institute in the afternoon. **Please note that the dismissal time is 11:30 AM.**

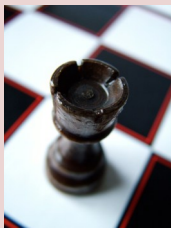
### BOOK CLUB BEGINS
